ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be licensed practicing Registered Nurses with evidence of a basic nursing programme leading to the award of a diploma, certificate or degree from an accredited School of Nursing. Applicants should also have evidence of GPA of 2.5 or average grade of C or higher in a general nursing programme.
2. Applicant should have at least three (3) years working experience, part of which should be in the Intensive Care Unit, Recovery Room, Operating Theatre or Accidents and Emergency.
3. Applicants would benefit from having a background in:

 - ✓ submit a written application
 - ✓ attend a personal interview
 - ✓ submit a medical certificate
